Pasadena Livestock Show & Rodeo 2017 - Expectations of Beauty Pageant Winners

Consequences of not upholding the standards and the expectations of the PLS&R beauty pageant may result in the termination of your title. In this event, the first runner up will take the place as the title-holder. At the time of termination, the scholarship (if applicable), sash, and crown shall be returned to the PLS&R office immediately.

APPEARANCE: You are expected to maintain the appearance with which you won your title, including hair and makeup. For example, if you had blonde hair the day you were crowned, you are expected to maintain blonde hair throughout your reign. This helps people become familiar with you and recognize you at rodeo events.

EVENTS AND APPEARANCES: Winning a title for the PLS&R is a yearlong commitment with appearances throughout. Winners will receive a calendar of scheduled events; however, at times spontaneous events may arise. If there is a conflict in attending an event, the General Chairman and Assistant General Chairman must be notified within 5 days of the event. Otherwise, the absence will be considered unexcused and will result in a mandatory meeting with the Chairman. **Repeated nonattendance will result in termination of your title.**

SOCIAL MEDIA: All social media sites, in which the winner participates, must be maintained in a tasteful and appropriate manner. This includes language and photography. Please be mindful of what you are posting and have posted in the past as you are representing the PLS&R. If asked by a PLS&R officer to remove any kind of derogatory or offensive pictures or comments, it must be taken down immediately.

BEHAVIOR IN PUBLIC: The winners are always representing the organization whether they are wearing their sash and crown or not. Therefore, all behavior in public must be of the highest standards of a young lady. This includes conversing with community members and PLS&R volunteers appropriately. Foul language will not be tolerated.

ATTIRE: The winners are expected to wear rodeo attire as asked by the PLS&R beauty pageant committee representatives. This includes no bare midriffs and no short shorts. Noncompliance will result in the young lady being given the option to change or leave.

RESPECTFULNESS: The winners are expected to be kind, courteous, and respectful to all PLS&R volunteers, leadership, and pageant representatives. Disrespect and poor attitudes will not be tolerated.

PLEASE NOTE – Immediately following crowning, we will hold a mandatory meeting for Young Miss, Junior Miss, Teen Miss, and Miss Pasadena Rodeo winners (and their guardians) to discuss these expectations for the year. This is a chance to ask questions and get to know each other.
